Sub: Preparation of Panel for Selection for the Post of Superintendent/Appraiser, Inspector on deputation in the Directorate General of Systems Delhi/Mumbai/Chennai.

Please refer to earlier deputation order F.No. II(3)/12/2014-Systems dated 26.04.2016 and 10.05.2016, the validity of the said letter is over the same may be extended for 90 days from the date of the issue of this letter.

Options are invited to fill up the following vacant posts **on deputation basis** in the Directorate General of Systems at Delhi /Mumbai/Chennai office:

2. These post will be filled up **on deputation basis** from amongst the officers of the similar ranks working in the formation of Customs, Central Excise and Service Tax and officers holding analogous posts in the Directorate General/ Directorates under CBEC in the same pay scale. **The age of the officer shall not exceed 56 years as on closing date of this circular.**

3. Such officers selected for a posting in the Directorate General of Systems at Delhi, would normally be appointed for a period of 3 years but extendable upto 5 years.

4. It is requested that applications of the interested and eligible officers may be forwarded to this Directorate General with their particulars viz, name, address, educational qualification, date of birth, History of Posting, present post and the date from which it is held, scale of pay, experience alongwith synopsis of their ACR Gradings, for the last five years and also "No objection Certificate" from the concerned Commissionerate/Director General/Directorate preferably **within 90 days from the issue of the circular**. It may also be brought to the notice of the willing officers that once they are selected, they will not be allowed to withdraw their candidature and also will not be relieved till the expiry of the tenure of three years. It may also be certified that no vigilance case is pending or being contemplated against any such officer.
5. The Superintendents/Inspectors who had already applied in response to earlier circular dated 26.04.2016 need not apply again and their names will be considered alongwith the new applications.
6. In case, while working in this Directorate General, the work and conduct of the officer is not found to be satisfactory, the officer can be reverted to the parent Commissionerate/Directorate before completion of the deputation period
7. Selected officers will have to make their own arrangement for residential accommodation.
8. Selected officers will be entitled for deputation allowance as per rules.
